The validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Village of Greenwood Lake, in the County of Orange, New York, is not authorized to expend money or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of publication of the notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENWOOD LAKE,  
NEW YORK, ADOPTED FEBRUARY 11, 2026, AUTHORIZING THE  
ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED  
\$135,000 TO FINANCE THE ACQUISITION OF A HEAVY-DUTY  
VEHICLE, INCLUDING EQUIPMENT APPURTENANT THERETO,  
STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$135,000  
AND APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT FOR SUCH PURPOSE

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is the acquisition of a heavy-duty vehicle, including equipment appurtenant thereto, at the estimated maximum cost of \$135,000.

The period of usefulness is fifteen (15) years.

The maximum amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$135,000.
