

## RESOLUTION

A Meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Greenwood Lake, New York was convened on **March 11, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.**

The following Resolution was duly  
offered and seconded to wit:

### **RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2026 TITLED A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING A PROPERTY TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW § 3-C**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of the Village of Greenwood Lake, New York (“Village Board”) from time to time reviews its laws, rules and regulations to be certain the same are consistent with all current lawful practices as well as best practices to protect the health, safety and welfare of Village residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board desires to adopt a Local Law Authorizing A Property Tax Levy In Excess Of The Limit Established In General Municipal Law § 3-C; and

**WHEREAS**, such introductory Local Law was introduced before the Village Board on February 11, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, upon notice duly published and posted, a Public Hearing was held on said Local Law on February 11, 2026 wherein public discussion was heard concerning the merits of said Local Law and after hearing from all those present afforded an opportunity to speak, the Village Board declared the public hearing closed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Board as follows:

Section 1. All “WHEREAS” paragraphs are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full.

Section 2. The Village Board hereby adopts Local Law No. 2 of 2026 entitled, “A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING A PROPERTY TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW § 3-C” as attached hereto as Schedule “A.”

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to enter said Local Law into the minutes of this meeting and in the Local Law book of the Village of Greenwood Lake, and to give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law by filing the Local Law in the Office of the Secretary of State in the State of New York.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
