

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATION

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on Tuesday, May 20, 2026, at 6:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, a Public Hearing will be held before the Board of Trustees of the Village of Greenwood Lake at Village Hall, located at 18 Church Street, Greenwood Lake, New York.

The Village of Greenwood Lake will hold a public hearing so that the public may offer comments and suggestions regarding a proposed application to the Orange County Office of Community Development for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding in an amount between \$75,000 and \$275,000. The proposed project consists of the installation of a new elevator at the Village Courthouse/Municipal Building in order to provide ADA-compliant access to the Village Court and the meeting room where Village Board meetings are conducted.

The Action Plan functions as a planning document, an application for Federal funds, and a strategy to be followed in administering HUD Programs. The 2027 County Annual Action Plan will be prepared and submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on or before November 15, 2026, or upon such date as instructed by HUD.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to obtain the views of residents of the Village, public agencies, and other interested parties regarding housing and community development needs; to suggest projects to address such needs; and to affirmatively further fair housing. There will be a discussion of community development needs within the Village, the proposed ADA accessibility improvement project, and a review of any previous projects funded with CDBG monies.

Organizations representing persons with low- and moderate-incomes, as well as low- and moderate-income residents, are encouraged to attend this hearing so that their views can be heard, as the CDBG Program principally benefits persons of low and moderate income.

The Village of Greenwood Lake will make reasonable accommodations and services necessary for citizens with sensory impairments and disabilities at the public hearing. Translation services may be offered upon request and availability. Persons requiring such accommodations or services should contact the Village at least three (3) working days in advance of the meeting.
